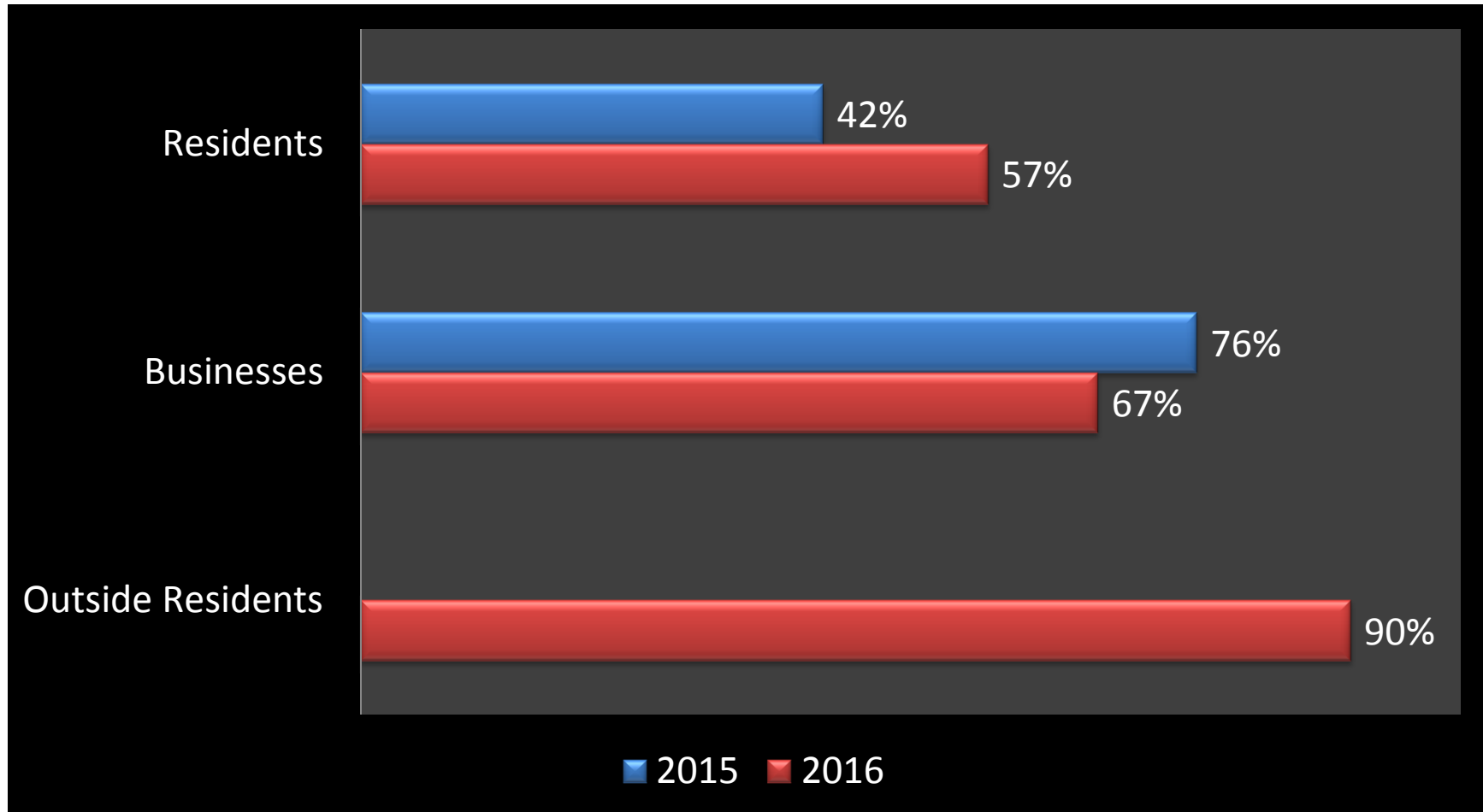


Awareness: I believe people and/or organizations are trying to reduce crime in Jacobsville.



Lack of Social Bonding and Cohesiveness

- Survey data reveals mixed findings about social bonding within the neighborhood.
- On one hand...Only 16% of residents and 15% of business agree that Jacobsville is a close-knit neighborhood AND only 28% of residents and 30% of businesses feel connected to other people in the neighborhood.
- On the other hand...Residents cited their neighbors as one of the top things they like about the neighborhood, and businesses noted the collaboration and positive relationships with other business owners.

Over the last year, which statement best describes how you feel about the Jacobsville neighborhood?			
Response	Residents	Business	Outside Residents*
This neighborhood has improved a great deal.	7%	8%	34%
This neighborhood has improved somewhat.	31%	48%	51%
This neighborhood has improved very little.	34%	28%	5%
This neighborhood has not improved at all.	45%	18%	2%

- Area around CVS/Braun's Nursing Home

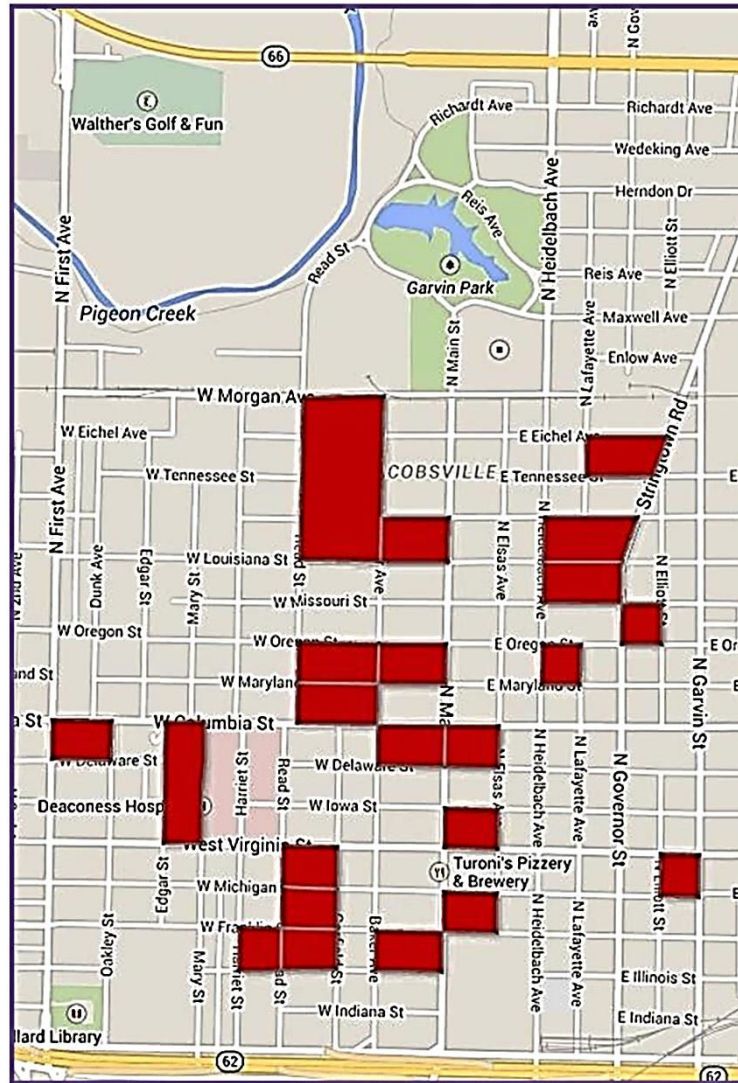
Crime is remaining consistent around:
